Reedom Elementary School General Education Preschool Students' Interest Application

Reedom Elementary School is pleased to provide an opportunity for preschool children within our community to be general education students for the 2022-2023 school year. The purpose of a general education peer is to provide students with disabilities or delays positive role models with age appropriate social behavior and language skills.

In order for your child to qualify to be a general education peer, they must meet the specific requirements listed below:

Child must be 3/4 years old Child must be toilet trained Child must display age appropriate language skills Child must be independent and be able to be away from home for extended periods of time Child must be a positive role model Child must be able to understand and interact well with adults and children

A "MEET AND GREET" will be held on Friday, May 20, 2022, from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Times will be broken up into 3 sessions. The purpose of this Meet and Greet will be for our Early Childhood staff to observe and interact with your child. During this time, Ms. Morseburg our Early Childhood teacher and Ms. Grant our special education teacher, will be observing social interactions, language, attention to task, and ability to follow directions. In addition, it is encouraged that your child be able to display pre-academic skills/knowledge, such as counting and recognizing colors, shapes, letters and numbers. The Meet and Greet is essential to confirm that children qualify to be a general education peer, prior to the lottery process, thus helping to ensure the success and growth of those students with disabilities and delays.

If you are interested in having your child be a general education peer, you must fill out and return the application below to Reedom Elementary School on or before May 16, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. Someone will contact you with a time to bring your child to the Meet and Greet on Friday, May 20, 2022.

If your child is selected, registration is required and updated immunization records must be provided. Parents will be required to transport to and from school and ensure that consistent attendance occurs with the exception of illness. You will need to be on time every day to drop off/pick up your child. If this becomes an issue or your child does not display age appropriate behavior or social skills in the classroom, your child may be removed from the program. This program will begin the first day of the 2022-2023 school year, which is August 8, 2022. It will be a half-day program and held Monday through Thursday. The morning session will be from 9:10 a.m. to 11:35 a.m. and the afternoon session will be from 12:55 p.m., to 3:21 p.m. Ms. Morseburg's program is a general education inclusion program.
